Air Canada Nonstop Service to Toronto Coming to Ford International

Gerald R. Ford International Airport (GFIA) is pleased to welcome new Air Canada nonstop service from GFIA to Toronto's Lester B. Pearson International Airport. This three-times-daily service is scheduled to launch Monday, July 14. Tickets are now available for purchase at <http://www.aircanada.com>. The addition of this new service will bring to 16 the number of nonstop destinations available at GFIA, and will mark the return of international service at GFIA.

With scheduled daily departures at 6:05 a.m., 10:20 a.m. and 6:20 p.m., flights are conveniently timed to connect at Toronto Pearson International – Air Canada's largest hub – to the carrier's extensive cross-Canada network, as well as its international flights featuring lay flat beds in business class to major international destinations: London Heathrow, Frankfurt, Tel Aviv, Hong Kong, Beijing, Shanghai and Tokyo.

Gerald R. Ford International is the second busiest airport in Michigan, and ranks among the top 15% of busiest airports in the U.S. The airport currently serves approximately 2 million passengers annually.
