Flying High to the Mile-High City

United Airlines announces nonstop Denver service from Ford Airport

May 17, 2006 – United Airlines, which currently serves Chicago’s O’Hare International Airport from Gerald R. Ford International, has expanded its service offerings by announcing plans to offer daily nonstop jet service to its hub at Denver International Airport, with the inaugural flight of this new Grand Rapids-to-Denver service scheduled for Wednesday, September 6, 2006. Passengers will be flown aboard a Canadair Regional Jet (CRJ) 700 aircraft, with six first-class, 28 economy-plus, and 32 economy-class seats. The service will be operated by SkyWest Airlines, a regional affiliate of United.
